Client Update

We are amazed at the growth of our ultrasound clinic. During the months of May-July, we scheduled 49 ultrasounds! We referred 4 clients for adoption services and supported 4 clients who walked through miscarriage.

As of August 1st, clients have completed 1,105 parenting and life skills courses,, which is an 80% increase in course completions. We offer Parenting without Shame, Autism classes, Nutrition, Toddler care, Infant care, Self care and Bible study courses just to name a few.

We have distributed over 11,000 diapers and over 223 cans of formula. We've experienced an increase of need for preemie and newborn clothing, diapers, bottles, hooded towels and toys. Our layette bags are delivered monthly to both Grayling and Gaylord hospitals.

We have great need for new Bibles that we can distribute to clients. We have seen an increase in clients bound to addiction, witchcraft and brokenness, but they are longing for an encounter with our loving Savior, Jesus. In June and July, we were honored to lead five clients to the foot of the cross and encounter grace and forgiveness.

We are in awe of what the Lord is doing through New Life!



Programs


