From the DIRECTOR

"We have heard the call to stand in the strength of the Lord and let our light shine before men so they will see His light and glorify God."

Over the years, I have marveled at the strength of a lighthouse. Years ago, I had the opportunity to serve at a quaint Maritime Museum.

There, I would learn about the tragedy of the SS Carl D. Bradley that sunk on November 18, 1958, where only two crew members survived. I heard the testimonies of sailors who survived the SS Cedarville that sank on May 7, 1965, where 11 lives were lost, and the shock these sailors felt 40 years later as they tried to reconcile the events of that fateful day. I heard many sailors share their stories and how the erupting sound from the lighthouse on foggy days saved countless lives.

I reflect on these memories as I read Isaiah 60:1-3, Psalm 107:25-30 and Mark 6:45-52. I can hear the echos of the sailors, whose hearts melted from trouble, who were at wit's end, violently tossed as the tempest of waves crashed against their ship, taunting them with what seemed to be imminent death. But, in the midst of chaos, they looked

into the stormy sea, where Jesus walked and spoke, "Be of good cheer, it is I, do not be afraid" (Matthew 14:27 KJV). The winds ceased; the waters calmed, and He led them to safety. He was the lighthouse in the storm.

He has called New Life to stand as a beacon of hope and healing, a symbol of strength and integrity, and let truth shine in the darkness. The team at New Life dedicates the first hour of the day to seek His face so we can release His love to those we serve. We have seen many challenging situations, heard heartbreaking testimonies, and cried many tears, both of joy and sorrow.

We have heard the call to stand in the strength of the Lord and let our light shine before men so they will see His light and glorify God. Together, with your financial support, prayers, and volunteerism, we can reach far and wide to bring the light of His countenance into the storm. "You guys are a lifesaver."



I had the opportunity in September to attend the Samaritan Summit, a national gathering of Pregnancy Resource Center leaders, held in Nashville, Tennessee. I instantly connected with the Michigan teams, as pictured above. These groups were from Holland, Grand Rapids, and Lansing.

At this Summit, we heard speakers from the Abortion Survivors Network, Leadership Coaching and Consulting, and SperaVita Focus Trainer regarding patient resources, medical professionals, legislative leaders, legal counsel, life advocates, philanthropists, women's care, and adoption agencies.

Some of the breakout sessions included: God sized vision creating a strategic plan in a Post-Roe world, chemical abortion and abortion pill reversal, trauma training, public relations, how to build an engaged Board of Directors, building cohesive leadership teams, creating a coalition, client services from a medical perspective, marketing/branding and keys to effective follow-up.

We met with Capacity Building teams and developed SMART goals, established accountability partners, and created an action plan.

The week I returned, we had our first Spanish-speaking client at the Center. Because of the incredible relationships built during our breakout sessions, we connected with our friends at Holland PRC and received the forms and support needed to assist our new client.

We are working with Lansing PRC to explore Sexual Risk Avoidance training, and we were also able to connect with Positive Options PRC for further training of our team. Michigan has also started a coalition that strengthens one another and stands as a united team across our state through sharing information, legal counsel, process development, and more.

I am so thankful to have had the opportunity to meet directors of many seasons at this valued conference. Our team has greatly benefited and will continue to grow as we connect with PRC across our region, state, and nation. We are stronger together!

It was truly an honor to sit with teams across the United States that have heard the call to serve the Lord and protect the unborn and born.

LAMS PROGRAM

We understand there are many people who are not equipped with tools to help them speak to the broken about new life issues. It is often uncomfortable to get into conversations that are out of our own personal experiences/understanding. LAM training will equip mentors to have the knowledge and in-depth education on how to get through those hard conversations while making the individual feel loved, heard, and understood.

The LAMs program is meant to bring emotional healing, parental support, mentoring both men and women, to introduce clients to our Beloved Savior, Jesus. We are an extension of the corporate Body of Christ, calling on our partners, to join us in this life affirming mission. This partnership would help us bridge clients to your fellowship for discipleship and spiritual growth. We would be honored to have you support this mission and help bring healing to the brokenhearted, hope to the hopeless and strength to the weary. We are better together.

EDUCATION PROGRAM

We offer educational classes through evidence-based BrightCourse lessons. New lessons are created using scientific studies and analysis to provide accurate content that leads to scientifically-sound decision-making. In most cases, BrightCourse provides factsheets to see the studies, scientific journals and medically produced resources to build the recommendations of each video. In addition, most lessons are built using outcome-based research. These practices have been studied to show positive results. 
